## REMEMBER

What's happening with the Healthcare Supply Chain Leadership Hall of Fame™

The Board of Directors (BOD) and Advisory Council (AC) are working on these key projects:

- 1. Mark your calendars: The 18<sup>th</sup> annual Bellwether League Foundation Induction & Recognition Event (BLFIRE18) is scheduled for Monday, November 10, 2025, at Wayne State University in Detroit. In the next edition of REMEMBER (scheduled for late April), we'll share with you our thoughtful and unique reason for moving BLFIRE18 a month later from our historical and traditional spot at the start of National Healthcare Supply Chain Management Week.
- 2. **Giving:** To date, eight Sustaining Sponsors have renewed with us for another year. - 6. **Debuting:** BLF is launching two service programs this year ... technically, one is an updated relaunch. The first is scheduled to debut at the University of Arkansas. Several Bellwether Community members will participate in our inaugural "BLF Goes Back to School" panel discussion, sharing relevant and useful information about provider-based healthcare supply chain management with attending students. BLF opens this educational opportunity to all colleges and universities offering undergraduate and graduate supply chain programs. This program joins our annual Collegiate Capstone Projects and dedicated scholarships as insightful ways BLF can introduce college students to mission-driven, provider-based supply chain and ideally open the door to hands-on internship opportunities. The second is BLF's **Supply Chain Maturity Assessment Tool (SCMAT)**, which enables healthcare provider organizations to self-evaluate the maturity of their supply chain operations. BLF originally licensed SCMAT for several years before the pandemic, but renewed interest motivated us to update the tool for the post-pandemic era.
